DAY 01: Thursday July 17. WASHINGTON, DULLES / LONDON. Depart Dulles for overnight flight to London.

DAY 02: Friday July 18. LONDON Upon your arrival in London, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. The balance of the day is at leisure.

DAY 03: Saturday July 19. Tour of Black London & Brixton Visit sites of Pan African Congresses Black and other historic sites.

Evening Lecture at Local venue: Featuring Paul Obinna and Tony Browder. This event is open to the public.

DAY 04: Sunday July 20. BRITISH MUSEUM Visit to the British Museum to view original Egyptian artifacts, copies of which reside in the Cairo Museum. Have Lunch then travel to Greenwich to visit site of the Prime Meridian

DAY 05: Monday July 21. LONDON Tour of London focusing mainly on historical sites. Big Ben, Houses of Parliament. Visit Westminster Abbey. Continue to Whitehall, the Mall, Buckingham Palace. See the Tower of London. Return to your hotel.

DAY 06: Tuesday July 22. LONDON / PARIS Depart London after breakfast via private motorcoach across the countryside to Dover where you will board the Hovercraft to cross the English Channel to Calais. Upon arrival in Calais, you will continue your drive to Paris via the Battlefields of Northern France. Overnight in Paris.

DAY 07: Wednesday July 23. Louvre Museum. Continue to the Place de la Concorde, Champs Elysees, l'Arc de Triomphe, stop at Statue of Liberty, Eiffel Tower, Moulin Rouge, Eglise de la Trinite, the Opera and Rue de Rivoli. Afternoon at leisure.

DAY 08: Thursday July 24. Black Paris Tour and tour of the Musee des Arts Africains et Oceaniens . Rest of day at Leisure.

DAY 09: Friday July 25. Morning at Leisure. Evening Lecture at Local venue: Featuring local historian and Tony Browder. This event is open to the public

DAY 10: Saturday July 26. PARIS / WASHINGTON, DULLES Transfer to the airport for your return flight to Washington, Dulles. Arrival in Washington, Dulles the afternoon the same day.
